e-referral exclusion advice

The DOH has made a number of changes to the exclusion criteria. The new exclusions are as follows:

- Any person under the age of 18 years old
- Any patient with an American Society of Anaesthesiologists (ASA) score of 3 (who is unstable), unless the appropriate critical care facilities that meet the 'levels of critical care for adult patients' standards and guidelines (Intensive Care Society 2002) are available
- Any patient with a BMI greater than 35, unless no co-morbidities and then a maximum of 40
- A patient who has a current and significantly unstable psychiatric disorder where the approved facility cannot reasonably be expected to accommodate the patient's needs

Helpful guidance when referring an NHS patient to Sussex Premier Health on e-RS

A few things to look out for when referring a patient via e-RS to Sussex Premier Health:

- Service name is always Sussex Premier Health – Code U9D3W
- Service Location is Sussex Premier Health , not Conquest Hospital
- Service type (the last column on your search) should always be First Outpatient, not Triage Service
